PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

AT 27-YEARS-OLD, HE LAUNCHES HIS 2022 US OPEN CAMPAIGN WITH SURGING MOMENTUM. THIS YEAR, HE CAPTURED HIS FIRST GRAND SLAM DOUBLES TITLE AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN - REACHED HIS FIRST GRAND SLAM SINGLES FINAL AT WIMBLEDON - WON HIS 7TH CAREER SINGLES TITLE IN WASHINGTON D.C. - LIFTED TWO MORE DOUBLES TROPHIES IN ATLANTA AND WASHINGTON D.C. - AND EARLIER THIS MONTH, DEFEATED WORLD #1 DANIIL MEDVEDEV IN MONTREAL.
