LAST YEAR - AT JUST 18-YEARS-OLD, IN HIS US OPEN DEBUT - HE ANNOUNCED HIS ARRIVAL AS ONE OF THE MOST TALENTED AND DETERMINED YOUNG STARS OF THE GAME - DEFEATING WORLD #3 STEFANOS TSITSIPAS IN A 5TH-SET TIEBREAK - RIGHT HERE IN ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM. HE FINISHED THE SEASON BY CAPTURING THE TITLE AT THE NEXTGEN ATP TOUR FINALS - AND THIS YEAR, HAS REACHED 6 FINALS, WINNING 4 TITLES - INCLUDING MASTERS-1000 TROPHIES IN MIAMI AND MADRID - WHERE HE DEFEATED WORLD #1 NOVAK DJOKOVIC. THIS AFTERNOON, HE RETURNS TO THE SPORT'S BIGGEST STAGE AFTER A TREMENDOUS 2022 - WHERE (SO FAR), HE'S REACHED THE FINALS IN DALLAS AND ATLANTA, UPSET WORLD #5 STEFANOS TSITSIPAS IN INDIAN WELLS, CRACKED THE ATP'S TOP-35, AND REACHED THE 3RD-ROUND IN HIS WIMBLEDON DEBUT. BACK IN THE 3RD-ROUND OF THE US OPEN WITH STRAIGHT SETS VICTORIES OVER SERBIA'S DUSAN LAJOVIC AND CROATIA'S BORNA CORIC. FROM SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA - PLEASE WELCOME JENSON BROOKSBY.
