PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

THE NUMBER-5 SEED – THIS 23-YEAR-OLD IS ONE OF TWO REMAINING PLAYERS AT THIS YEAR'S US OPEN WHO COULD LEAVE NEW YORK...AS THE NEW #1 PLAYER IN THE WORLD. ON TUESDAY - IN DOMINANT FASHION - HE DEFEATED SURGING ITALIAN MATTEO BERRETTINI IN STRAIGHT SETS - AND THIS AFTERNOON, RETURNS TO THE SPOTLIGHT IN ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM, BATTLING FOR A SPOT IN HIS SECOND GRAND SLAM FINAL OF THE YEAR. IN JUST 3 SEASONS, HE'S WON 9 ATP SINGLES TITLES, REACHED 13 FINALS, CLIMBED TO A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #5 - AND 3-MONTHS-AGO, WON SIX CONSECUTIVE MATCHES AT ROLAND GARROS TO REACH HIS FIRST GRAND SLAM FINAL. FROM NORWAY - PLEASE WELCOME CASPER RUUD.

RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #8 - HE'S A DAVIS CUP CHAMPION, AN OLYMPIC SILVER MEDALIST, IS 6-TIME TOUR-LEVEL FINALIST, AND OWNS 3 ATP SINGLES TITLES - INCLUDING THE 2018 PARIS MASTERS, WHERE HE UPSET NOVAK DJOKOVIC TO LIFT THE TROPHY.
