PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

THE MOST DOMINANT WTA TALENT OF 2022 - TONIGHT, THIS 21-YEAR-OLD, 2-TIME ROLAND GARROS CHAMPION RETURNS TO THE BRIGHT LIGHTS OF ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM, BATTLING FOR A SPOT IN HER FIRST *HARD-COURT* GRAND SLAM FINAL. IN ONE OF THE MOST REMARKABLE SEASONS IN RECENT HISTORY – EARLIER THIS YEAR, SHE WON 37 CONSECUTIVE MATCHES, CAPTURING 6 TITLES, IN THE LONGEST WTA WIN-STREAK OF THE 21ST CENTURY. WITH POWER AND INTENSITY - OVER THE PAST 5-SEASONS, SHE'S CATAPULTED TO THE TOP OF THE SPORT - EARNING 10 SINGLES TITLES, REACHING 17 FINALS, ASCENDING ALL THE WAY TO BECOME THE #2 PLAYER IN THE WORLD.
