CONSTANT | SINGLES BIO FROM THE 2023 QATAR EXXONMOBIL OPEN

WHAT THIS 30-YEAR-OLD HAS ACCOMPLISHED OVER THE PAST 14-MONTHS CAN'T SIMPLY BE DEFINED AS "A BREAKTHROUGH," IT'S MORE...LIKE A RENAISSANCE. LAST YEAR, HE STARTED THE SEASON RANKED OUTSIDE THE TOP-200, BUT BATTLED WEEK OVER WEEK ON THE CHALLENGER TOUR - AND BY THE END OF THE YEAR, WON THREE CHALLENGER TITLES IN 5 FINALS, REACHED HIS FIRST ATP TOUR SEMIFINAL IN TEL AVIV, AND ENDED THE YEAR RANKED INSIDE THE TOP-70. MAKING HIS DOHA DEBUT - FROM FRANCE - PLEASE WELCOME, CONSTANT LESTIENNE.

BOTIC | SINGLES BIO FROM THE QATAR EXXONMOBIL OPEN

IN JUST TWO SEASONS, THIS 27-YEAR-OLD'S BECOME THE SPORT'S TOP DUTCH TALENT AND A TOP-40 FIXTURE ON TOUR. IN 2021, HE STARTED THE SEASON RANKED OUTSIDE THE TOP-40 - BUT QUALIFIED AT ALL FOUR MAJORS, INCLUDING AN UNFORGETTABLE RUN AT THE US OPEN - WHERE HE WON SEVEN CONSECUTIVE MATCHES, DEFEATING 2 TOP-15 PLAYERS TO REACH THE QUARTERFINALS. LAST YEAR, HE CONTINUED HIS CLIMB - REACHING HIS FIRST ATP FINAL IN MUNICH, THE ROUND OF 16 AT WIMBLEDON, AND BY AUGUST - CLIMBED TO A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #22.
