LATE LAST SEASON, HE WAS UNBEATABLE - LAUNCHING A 16-MATCH WIN STREAK IN OCTOBER - CAPTURING TITLES IN FLORENCE, ANTWERP AND BASEL - BEFORE REACHING HIS SECOND MASTERS-1000 SEMIFINAL...IN PARIS. AFTER THE STREAK, HE CLIMBED TO A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #6, QUALIFIED FOR THE ATP FINALS, AND CAPPED THE SEASON BY LIFTING HIS COUNTRY TO ITS FIRST-EVER DAVIS CUP TITLE.
