AND SIMPLY PUT - HE'S BEEN ON FIRE THIS SEASON. AT THE UNITED CUP, HE TOOK-OUT US OPEN FINALIST ALEXANDER ZVEREV. AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN, HE REACHED HIS FIRST GRAND SLAM QUARTERFINAL - ELIMINATING WORLD #12 CAM NORRIE, THEN WORLD #7 FELIX AUGER-ALIASSIME - TO REACH THE FINAL-8.
