ALEXANDER ZVEREV WON THEIR MOST RECENT CLASH 2-YEARS-AGO AT INDIAN WELLS - IN A SECOND SET TIEBREAK.

PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

ON MONDAY NIGHT, IN DRAMATIC FASHION, HE SAVED THREE MATCH POINTS - DEFEATING LORENZO SONEGO IN A DECIDING-SET TIEBREAK, IN ONE OF THE MOST MEMORABLE 1ST-ROUND MATCHES IN TOURNAMENT HISTORY. AND FANS, IT WAS 16-YEARS-AGO (AT JUST 19-YEARS-OLD) - HE REACHED THE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH IN HIS DOHA DEBUT - THEN RETURNED TO WIN BACK-TO-BACK TITLES IN 2008 AND 2009 - OUTPERFORMING FELLOW TOP-TALENTS LIKE STAN WAWRINKA, ANDY RODDICK, AND ROGER FEDERER TO LIFT THE FALCON. IN ALL, HE OWNS 46 ATP SINGLES TITLES, HAS REACHED AN ASTOUNDING 70 CAREER FINALS, IS A 3-TIME GRAND SLAM CHAMPION, 2-TIME OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALIST, A DAVIS CUP CHAMPION, AND HELD THE SPORT'S TOP RANKING FOR 41 CONSECUTIVE WEEKS. FROM GREAT BRITAIN - PLEASE WELCOME ANDY MURRAY.
