JUST A FEW WEEKS BACK - HE CELEBRATED HIS MOST MOMENTOUS FORTNIGHT IN MELBOURNE - WHEN HE AND RINKY HIJIKATA (AS WILD CARDS) CAPTURED THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN DOUBLES TITLE. OVER THE YEARS, HE'S AMASSED 7 CHALLENGER TOUR SINGLES TITLES, 13 FUTURES TITLES...AND NOW - AT 29-YEARS-OLD - HAS PLANTED HIS STAKE IN THE SPORT'S TOP-TOUR, GOING TOE-TO-TOE WITH THE BEST IN THE GAME, ON TENNIS' BIGGEST STAGES.
