## PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

IN 2019 - AS A QUALIFIER RANKED OUTSIDE THE TOP-130 - SHE UPSET SAM STOSUR AND HSIEH SU-WEI TO REACH THE QUARTERFINALS IN HER DOHA DEBUT. THAT YEAR, SHE WENT-ON TO REACH HER FIRST CAREER TOUR-LEVEL FINAL, CAPTURED HER FIRST TITLE, JUMPED OVER 100-SPOTS IN THE RANKINGS, AND QUALIFIED FOR THE YEAR-END WTA ELITE TROPHY, WHERE SHE REACHED THE SEMIFINALS. NOW - 4-YEARS-LATER - SHE'S AN AUSTRALIAN OPEN SEMIFINALIST, A 2-TIME WIMBLEDON QUARTERFINALIST, AND HAS BEEN RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #19. BACK IN DOHA, COMPETING IN HER 3RD QATAR TOTAL ENERGIES OPEN - FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC, PLEASE WELCOME KAROLINA MUCHOVA.
