A 2-TIME QATAR TOTAL ENERGIES OPEN CHAMPION, SHE REMAINS ONE OF THE MOST SUCCESSFUL TALENTS IN THE HISTORY OF THE TOURNAMENT - AND IS ONE OF ONLY TWO PLAYERS WHO'VE REACHED THE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH 3-TIMES.
