PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

IN 1997, AS AN UNSEEDDED 17-YEAR-OLD, SHE WENT ON TO REACH HER FIRST GRAND SLAM FINAL HERE IN THE NEWLY DEDICATED ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM. 26 YEARS LATER, SHE OWNS 73 SINGLES, DOUBLES AND MIXED DOUBLES TITLES – INCLUDING SEVEN GRAND SLAM SINGLES TITLES, AND WITH SISTER SERENA...14 GRAND SLAM DOUBLES TITLES. SHE IS A 4-TIME OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALIST, A BILLIE JEAN KING CUP CHAMPION, AND IN 2002 BECAME THE FIRST AFRICAN AMERICAN WOMAN TO ASCEND TO WORLD #1 IN THE OPEN ERA. FROM PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLORIDA – PLEASE WELCOME 2-TIME US OPEN CHAMPION, VENUS WILLIAMS.

PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

BORN IN NEW YORK CITY, BADOSA SAYS THE US OPEN IS HER FAVORITE TOURNAMENT - AND MADE HER GRAND SLAM DEBUT HERE IN NEW YORK AS A 17-YEAR-OLD QUALIFIER IN 2015. HER BREAKTHROUGH SEASON CAME IN 2021 - WHERE SHE CAPTURED HER FIRST WTA SINGLES TITLE IN BELGRADE, REACHED THE QF AT ROLAND GARROS, REACHED THE QUARTERFINALS IN HER OLYMPIC DEBUT, CAPTURED THE WTA-1000 TITLE AT INDIAN WELLS, CRACKED THE TOP-10 FOR THE FIRST TIME, AND QUALIFIED FOR THE WTA FINALS...WHERE SHE REACHED THE SEMIFINALS IN HER YEAR-END CHAMPIONSHIP DEBUT. SHE THEN STARTED OFF 2022 BY CAPTURING HER 3RD CAREER TITLE IN SYDNEY. UNDEFEATED IN TOUR LEVEL FINALS, UNFORTUNATELY SHE'S STILL RECOVERING FROM A STRESS FRACTURE ON HER SPINE SUFFERED DURING THE CLAY SEASON IN ROME. BADOSA WITHDREW ON SATURDAY BEFORE THE US OPEN BEGAN.
