BACK ON CENTER STAGE IN ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM - WHERE LAST YEAR, HE LIFTED HIS FIRST GRAND SLAM SINGLES TROPHY - THIS 20-YEAR-OLD...HAS COMPLETELY TAKEN THE SPORT BY STORM. PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

AT 22-YEARS-OLD, HE MADE HIS ATP TOUR DEBUT LAST YEAR - AND IN JUST 15 MONTHS, HAS CAPTURED 4 CHALLENGER TOUR SINGLES TITLES, REACHED 6 FINALS, AND LEAPT OVER 200 SPOTS IN THE RANKINGS. EARLIER THIS YEAR, ON THE CLAY IN MADRID, HE UPSET WORLD #4 CASPER RUUD. THIS SUMMER, HE REACHED HIS FIRST TOUR-LEVEL SEMIFINAL IN UMAG. AND ON SATURDAY, OVER ON COURT-17, EARNED A STRAIGHT-SETS TRIUMPH OVER WORLD #16 CAM NORRIE, BOOKING HIS SPOT HERE - ON THE SPORT'S BIGGEST STAGE - IN THE US OPEN ROUND OF 16. FROM ITALY — BACK IN IN NEW YORK WITH A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #61 - PLEASE WELCOME, MATTEO ARNALDI.
