WITH TRADEMARK POWER AND INTENSITY, SHE HAS BEEN AN UNRELENTING TOP-10 TALENT FOR THE PAST 3-YEARS — AND ON MONDAY, WILL ASCEND TO THE TOP OF THE SPORT — AND FOR THE FIRST TIME, BECOME THE #1 PLAYER IN THE WORLD.
