THE FINALIST LAST YEAR AT ROLAND GARROS - IN 2017 (AT JUST 13-YEARS-OLD), SHE BECAME THE YOUNGEST JUNIOR FINALIST IN US OPEN HISTORY. TODAY, SIX YEARS LATER (AND STILL A TEENAGER), SHE...IS ONE OF AMERICA'S MARQUEE ATHLETES. A TOP-10 TALENT IN BOTH SINGLES AND DOUBLES, SHE'S A 3-TIME GRAND SLAM FINALIST, OWNS 6 WTA SINGLES TITLES, 8 DOUBLES TITLES, AND LAST SUMMER - BECAME THE #1 DOUBLES PLAYER IN THE WORLD. TONIGHT - ON A 10-MATCH STREAK, AFTER CAPTURING THE TITLE IN CINCINNATI - SHE TAKES CENTER STAGE AT HER HOME SLAM, UNDER THE LIGHTS IN ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM, COMPETING IN HER FIRST US OPEN SINGLES SEMIFINAL. THIS YEAR'S ROLAND GARROS FINALIST - TONIGHT, THIS 27-YEAR-OLD RETURNS TO THE BRIGHT LIGHTS OF ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM, THROUGH TO THE SEMIFINALS OF THE US OPEN FOR THE FIRST TIME. AT ROLAND GARROS, SHE UPSET WORLD #2 ARYNA SABALENKA TO REACH THE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH - THEN, OVER THE SUMMER IN CINCINNATI, UPSET SABALENKA AGAIN, REACHED HER FIRST WTA-1000 FINAL, AND TOUCHED-DOWN IN NEW YORK WITH A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #10. COMPETING IN HER 3RD GRAND SLAM SEMIFINAL, BATTLING FOR A SPOT IN HER SECOND MAJOR FINAL OF THE YEAR - FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC, PLEASE WELCOME KAROLINA MUCHOVA.
