PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

BACK IN DOHA FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE HIS SEMIFINAL-RUN 2-YEARS-AGO - HE IS NOW A 2-TIME GRAND SLAM SEMIFINALIST, A DAVIS CUP CHAMPION, AN OLYMPIC SILVER MEDALIST, IS A 7-TIME TOUR-LEVEL FINALIST - AND IN ALL, OWNS 5 CAREER SINGLES TITLES - INCLUDING THE 2018 PARIS MASTERS, WHERE HE UPSET NOVAK DJOKOVIC TO LIFT THE TROPHY. RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #8, 2-WEEKS-AGO HE MADE A RUN TO THE SEMIFINALS IN MARSEILLE - AND YESTERDAY, EARNED HIS 250TH CAREER MATCH VICTORY - RIGHT HERE, ON CENTER COURT IN DOHA. IN PURSUIT OF HIS 21ST CAREER SEMIFINAL - PLEASE WELCOME, KAREN KHACHANOV.

MAKING HIS DOHA QUARTERFINAL DEBUT - WEEK-1 IN HONG KONG, HE LAUNCHED 2024 WITH FOUR CONSECUTIVE MATCH VICTORIES TO REACH HIS SECOND ATP TOUR FINAL. IN MELBOURNE, HE NOTCHED HIS 100TH CAREER MATCH VICTORY AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN. AND JUST LAST WEEK, MADE A RUN TO THE QUARTERFINALS IN ROTTERDAM. RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #40 - LAST SEASON, HE SCORED TWO OF THE BIGGEST WINS OF HIS CAREER - WITH A STRAIGHT-SETS VICTORY OVER JANNICK SINNER ON THE GRASS IN S'HERTOGENBOSCH, AND A DECIDING-SET TIEBREAK TRIUMPH OVER ANDREY RUBLEV AT THE CINCINNATI MASTERS. LAST YEAR, HE REACHED THE **DOUBLES** SEMIFINALS ON THIS COURT - TONIGHT, HE'S DETERMINED TO EQUAL THE FEAT IN SINGLES. FROM FINLAND, PLEASE WELCOME EMIL RUUSUVUORI.
