PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

STILL IN HIGH SCHOOL, HE IS THE YOUNGEST TALENT IN THIS YEAR'S DRAW - AND YESTERDAY, EARNED THE BIGGEST WIN OF HIS YOUNG CAREER - DEFEATING WORLD #24 ALEJANDRO DAVIDOVICH FOKINA TO REACH THE ROUND OF 16. OVER THE PAST 6-MONTHS, HE HAS ROCKETED UP THE RANKINGS - STARTING WITH LAST SUMMER'S RUN AT US OPEN - WHERE, AS A 17-YEAR-OLD QUALIFIER, HE REACHED THE 3RD ROUND IN HIS GRAND SLAM DEBUT - BECOMING THE YOUNGEST PLAYER TO WIN A MAIN DRAW MATCH AT THE US OPEN IN 9-YEARS. THEN, LAST MONTH IN MELBOURNE, HE QUALIFIED AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN - AND DEFEATED FORMER TOP-10 TALENT DENIS SHAPOVALOV IN THE 1ST-ROUND. BATTLING FOR A SPOT IN HIS FIRST-EVER TOUR-LEVEL QUARTERFINAL - FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC - PLEASE WELCOME, JAKUB MENSİK.
