#### **PLAYER BIOGRAPHY**

STILL IN HIGH SCHOOL, HE IS THE YOUNGEST TALENT IN THIS YEAR'S DRAW - AND THIS AFTERNOON, MAKES HIS QATAR EXXONMOBIL OPEN DEBUT ON CENTER COURT, WITH A CAREER-HIGH RANKING JUST OUTSIDE THE TOP-100. OVER THE PAST 6-MONTHS, HE HAS ROCKETED UP THE RANKINGS - STARTING WITH LAST SUMMER'S RUN AT US OPEN - WHERE, AS A 17-YEAR-OLD QUALIFIER, HE REACHED THE 3RD ROUND IN HIS GRAND SLAM DEBUT - BECOMING THE YOUNGEST PLAYER TO WIN A MAIN DRAW MATCH AT THE US OPEN IN 9-YEARS. THEN, LAST MONTH IN MELBOURNE, HE QUALIFIED AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN - AND DEFEATED FORMER TOP-10 TALENT DENIS SHAPOVALOV IN THE 1ST-ROUND. LAST MAY, HE CAPTURED HIS FIRST CHALLENGER TOUR TITLE IN PRAGUE - IS NOW A 2-TIME CHALLLENGER FINALIST - AND JUST LAST WEEK, MADE A RUN TO THE SEMIFINALS IN BAHRAIN. FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC, PLEASE WELCOME, JAKUB MENSIK.

BACK IN DOHA AS A TOP-25 TALENT, THIS 24-YEAR-OLD RETURNS AFTER ANOTHER STELLAR SEASON PACKED WITH CLUTCH VICTORIES. LAST YEAR ON THE CLAY IN MADRID, HE KNOCKED-OUT WORLD #7 HOLGER RUNE. IN TORONTO, HE TRIUMPHED IN A DECIDING-SET TIEBREAK OVER WORLD #5 CASPER RUUD, PLAYED-ON TO REACH HIS 2ND MASTERS-1000 SEMIFINAL, AND CLIMBED TO A CAREER HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #21. THEN, LAST MONTH IN PERTH - HE LAUNCHED THE NEW YEAR WITH HIS 6TH CAREER TOP-10 WIN, DEFEATING WORLD #9 HUBERT HURKACZ AT THE UNITED CUP.
