COMPETING IN HER 7TH QATAR TOTAL ENERGIES OPEN - THIS 27-YEAR-OLD IS A 7-TIME GRAND SLAM DOUBLES CHAMPION, AN OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALIST, A WTA FINALS DOUBLES CHAMPION, A BILLIE JEAN KING CUP CHAMPION - AND IS ONE OF JUST A HANDFUL OF PLAYERS IN TENNIS HISTORY WHO'VE EARNED THE CAREER GOLDEN SLAM, AND SUPER SLAM. IN FACT, SHE'S HELD THE SPORT'S TOP DOUBLES RANKING FOR OVER 2-YEARS COMBINED - AND OWNS 24 DOUBLES TITLES IN 40 CAREER FINALS. ALSO A 10-TIME SINGLES FINALIST -- LAST YEAR, SHE CAPPED THE SEASON BY REACHING BACK-TO-BACK FINALS IN HONG KONG AND NANCHANG, WHERE SHE CAPTURED HER 5TH WTA SINGLES TITLE.
