COMPETING IN HER 7TH QATAR TOTALENERGIES OPEN - ON SUNDAY, SHE DEFEATED WILD CARD ZEYNEP SONMEZ - EARNING A SPOT IN TONIGHT'S MARQUEE MATCH-UP AGAINST ONE OF THE SPORT'S GREATEST TALENTS. IN ALL, SHE OWNS 4 CAREER SINGLES TITLES, IS A 6-TIME TOUR-LEVEL FINALIST - AND SINCE 2015, HAS EARNED 8 CAREER VICTORIES OVER TOP-10 OPPONENTS - INCLUDING A WIN OVER NAOMI OSAKA TO REACH THE 2019 BRISBANE FINAL. NOW A 3-TIME GRAND SLAM FINALIST - OVER THE PAST THREE YEARS, WITH UNRELENTING DETERMINATION, THIS TUNISIAN TRAILBLAZER HAS CEMENTED HER SPOT AT THE TOP OF THE SPORT - CAPTURING 5 TITLES, REACHING 13 FINALS, CLIMBING ALL THE WAY TO A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #2. IN 2012, SHE MADE HER DOHA DEBUT AS A 17-YEAR-OLD WILD CARD; TONIGHT - JUST 12-YEARS-LATER - SHE RETURNS AS A 2-TIME WIMBLEDON FINALIST, A US OPEN FINALIST - AND AS THE ONLY ARAB WOMAN EVER TO CONTEST A MAJOR FINAL...AND CRACK THE SPORT'S TOP-10.
