

PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

A 2-TIME DOHA CHAMPION AND 3-TIME FINALIST - YESTERDAY, SHE DEFEATED SURGING QUALIFIER MAGDELANA FRECH IN A DECIDING-SET - EARNING HER 20TH MATCH VICTORY HERE AT THE QATAR TOTAL ENERGIES OPEN. SINCE HER DOHA DEBUT AT THE WTA FINALS 15-YEARS-AGO, SHE HAS CEMENTED HER LEGACY AS ONE OF THE SPORT'S TOP TALENTS OF THE PAST TWO DECADES -- SHE'S A 2-TIME GRAND SLAM SINGLES CHAMPION, OWNS 21 SINGLES TITLES IN ALL - HAS REACHED 41 CAREER FINALS - IS AN OLYMPIC GOLD AND BRONZE MEDALIST - AND HELD THE WORLD #1 RANKING FOR A TOTAL OF 51-WEEKS COMBINED. YESTERDAY - IN HER QATAR TOTALENERGIES OPEN DEBUT - SHE UPSET WORLD #14 BEATRIZ HADDAD MAIA OF BRAZIL IN STRAIGHT SETS -- AND THIS AFTERNOON, FINDS HERSELF ON CENTER COURT, IN A MARQUEE MATCHUP WITH ONE OF THE MOST SUCCESSFUL TALENTS IN DOHA HISTORY.
