THE REIGNING ROLAND GARROS AND WIMBLEDON CHAMPION - TONIGHT, HE RETURNS TO CENTER STAGE IN ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM - WHERE IN 2022, HE LIFTED HIS FIRST GRAND SLAM SINGLES TROPHY. AND AT JUST 21-YEARs-OLD...HE HAS COMPLETELY TAKEN THE SPORT BY STORM. INCREDIBLY, IN JUST FOUR SEASONS, HE HAS AMASSED 4 GRAND SLAM SINGLES TITLES, 5 MASTERS-1000 TITLES, CAPTURED 15 TITLES IN ALL, HELD THE SPORT'S TOP-RANKING FOR 36-WEEKS COMBINED - AND EARLIER THIS MONTH IN PARIS, IN HIS SUMMER GAMES DEBUT, CAPTURED OLYMPIC SILVER FOR HIS COUNTRY.
