TODAY, SHE IS NOW A **2-TIME** GRAND SLAM CHAMPION! EARLIER THIS YEAR AT ROLAND GARROS, SHE CAPTURED HER FIRST GRAND SLAM <u>DOUBLES</u> TITLE - AND IN ALL (AT ONLY 20-YEARS-OLD), IS NOW A 5-TIME GRAND SLAM FINALIST. IN ALL, SHE NOW OWNS FOUR CAREER VICTORIES OVER TOP-10 OPPONENTS - AND LAST YEAR, REACHED HER FIRST WTA TOUR-LEVEL FINAL IN AUSTIN. 4-YEARS-AGO, SHE EARNED HER FIRST GRAND SLAM MAIN-DRAW MATCH VICTORIES HERE IN NEW YORK — TODAY, SHE FINDS HERSELF ON THE SPORT'S BIGGEST STAGE WITH A SHOT AT THE DEFENDING CHAMPION.
