PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

NOW A 5-TIME GRAND SLAM CHAMPION - EARLIER THIS YEAR, SHE CAPTURED HER 4TH (AND 3RD CONSECUTIVE) ROLAND GARROS TITLE - THEN RETURNED TO THE CLAY IN PARIS THIS SUMMER, WHERE SHE CLAIMED OLYMPIC BRONZE. AT JUST 23-YEARS-OLD - SHE IS THE REIGNING WTA FINALS CHAMPION, HAS AMASSED 22 CAREER SINGLES TITLES, REACHED 26 FINALS, IS A 2-TIME YEAR-END WORLD #1 - AND EARLIER THIS YEAR, BECAME ONE OF ONLY 8 WOMEN IN THE HISTORY TO HOLD THE SPORT'S TOP-RANKING FOR OVER 100-WEEKS COMBINED. THE CHAMPION HERE 2-YEARS-AGO - TODAY, SHE'S BACK ON THE SPORT'S BIGGEST STAGE COMPETING IN HER 6TH US OPEN. FROM POLAND - WELCOME BACK 2022 US OPEN CHAMPION, AND THE #1 PLAYER IN THE WORLD - IGA SWIATEK.

COMPETING IN HER 4TH US OPEN - REMARKABLY, FOR THE 3RD TIME, THIS 22-YEAR-OLD HAS REACHED THE MAIN DRAW HERE IN NEW YORK AS ONE OF QUALIFYING'S "LUCKY LOSERS" - AND THIS AFTERNOON, TAKES CENTER STAGE IN THE SEASON'S FINAL GRAND SLAM, WITH A SHOT AT THE SPORT'S TOP-RANKED TALENT. 3-YEARS-AGO, IN HER US OPEN DEBUT, SHE REACHED THE 3RD-ROUND OF A MAJOR FOR THE FIRST TIME - THEN REPEATED THE FEAT LAST SEASON ON THE CLAY AT ROLAND GARROS. IN ALL, SHE OWNS 4 WTA DOUBLES TITLES, IS A WTA-125 FINALIST, AND HAS CAPTURED 8 ITF WOMEN'S CIRCUIT SINGLES TITLES IN JUST 5 YEARS ON TOUR.
