PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

IT HAS BEEN A SUMMER TO REMEMBER FOR THIS 30-YEAR-OLD FROM UPSTATE. NOW A 2-TIME OLYMPIAN, SHE REPRESENTED TEAM USA AT PARIS 2024 - THEN RETURNED TO NORTH AMERICA AND LAUNCHED INTO A 9-MATCH WIN STREAK - CAPTURING HER 3RD WTA-1000 SINGLES TITLE IN TORONTO - BACKING-IT-UP WITH A RUN TO HER 5TH WTA-1000 FINAL IN CINCINNATI. SHE ALSO CAPTURED THE TITLE THIS YEAR IN BERLIN - AND IN ALL, NOW OWNS 6 CAREER SINGLES TITLES, IS A 12-TIME TOUR-LEVEL FINALIST, A ROLAND GARROS DOUBLES FINALIST, AND HAS BEEN RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #3. BACK UNDER THE LIGHTS IN ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM, WHERE SHE REACHED THE QUARTERFINALSS TWO YEARS AGO - FROM BUFFALO, NEW YORK - PLEASE WELCOME WORLD #6, JESSICA PEGULA.
