IN 2024, SHE REACHED HER FIRST GRAND SLAM SINGLES FINAL IN MELBOURNE, CAPTURED HER 3RD WTA SINGLES TITLE - AND OVER A MAGICAL 9 DAYS IN PARIS, UPSET WORLD #1 IGA SWIATEK EN-ROUTE TO OLYMPIC GOLD, TOPPING THE PODIUM AS THE 2024 OLYMPIC CHAMPION.
