PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

LAST YEAR, IN A RESURGENT SEASON - SHE REACHED HER FIRST GRAND SLAM FINAL AT ROLAND GARROS, AND AFTER A SEMIFINAL-RUN HERE IN NEW YORK, CLIMBED TO A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #8. THIS AFTERNOON, SHE'S BACK ON THE SPORT'S BIGGEST STAGE COMPETING IN HER 6TH GRAND SLAM QUARTERFINAL - AND SHE GOT HERE, WITHOUT DROPPING A SET. IN ROUND-2, SHE TOOK-OUT 2-TIME US CHAMPION NAOMI OSAKA - AND IN THE ROUND OF 16, EARNED HER 7TH CAREER TOP-5 VICTORY, ELIMINATING WORLD #5 JASMINE PAOLINI IN JUST OVER AN HOUR. BATTLING FOR A SPOT IN HER SECOND CONSECUTIVE US OPEN SEMIFINAL - FROM CZECHIA, PLEASE WELCOME KAROLINA MUCHOVA.

PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

MAKING HER ARTHUR ASHE STADIUM DEBUT - ON MONDAY, THIS 28 YEAR OLD DEFEATED 2-TIME US OPEN FINALIST AND AUSTRALIAN OPEN CHAMPION CAROLINE WOZNIACKI - AND TODAY, HERE IN THE SEASON'S FINAL MAJOR, BECOMES THE FIRST WOMAN FROM BRAZIL TO COMPETE IN THE US OPEN QUARTERFINALS SINCE MARIA BUENO IN 1968. A ROLAND GARROS SEMIFINALIST 2-YEARS-AGO, SHE OWNS 3 WTA SINGLES TITLES, HAS BEEN RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #10 - AND RIGHT BEFORE THE START OF THIS YEAR'S OPEN, REACHED HER 6TH CAREER SINGLES FINAL IN CLEVELAND. THE REIGNING WTA ELITE TROPHY CHAMPION IN BOTH SINGLES AND DOUBLES - LOOKING TO REACH HER SECOND GRAND SLAM SEMIFINAL - FROM BRAZIL, PLEASE WELCOME BEATRIZ HADDAD MAIA.
