PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

LAST YEAR, THIS 26-YEAR-OLD BECAME THE FIRST AMERICAN MAN TO CRACK THE SPORT'S TOP-5 SINCE ANDY RODDICK IN 2009. TONIGHT - AFTER TWO 4-SET TRIUMPHS OVER FORMER US OPEN FINALISTS CASPER RUUD AND ALEXANDER ZVEREV - HE STEPS BACK INTO THE SPOTLIGHT, HERE ON THE SPORT'S BIGGEST STAGE, COMPETING IN HIS FIRST EVER GRAND SLAM SEMIFINAL. IN ALL, HE OWNS 8 CAREER SINGLES TITLES, IS A 14-TIME TOUR-LEVEL FINALIST - AND OVER THE SUMMER IN PARIS, TEAMED WITH TOMMY PAUL TO EARN OLYMPIC BRONZE IN DOUBLES. ALSO IN PURSUIT OF HIS FIRST MAJOR FINAL - FROM RANCHO SANTA FE, CALIFORNIA - NEW YORK, WELCOME BACK TAYLOR FRITZ.
