2024 Q-TERMINALS QATAR CLASSIC

STILL UNDEFEATED AS A JUNIOR - LAST SEASON, IN HER Q-TERMINALS QATAR CLASSIC DEBUT - SHE REACHED THE LAST-16 OF A PLATINUM EVENT FOR THE FIRST TIME. BUT SHE WASN'T DONE. SHE THEN PLAYED-THROUGH TO THE QUARTERS OF BOTH THE US OPEN AND TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS - CAPTURED THE PSA-BRONZE "SQUASH ON FIRE" TITLE IN WASHINGTON D.C. - AND CAPPED THE SEASON WITH HER THIRD CONSECUTIVE TRIUMPH AT THE WORLD JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP. ON MONDAY - AT JUST 17-YEARS-OLD - SHE CRACKED THE PSA'S TOP-10 FOR THE FIRST TIME. BACK INSIDE THE GLASS IN DOHA, BATTLING FOR A SPOT IN HER FIRST PLATINUM SEMIFINAL - FROM EGYPT, PLEASE WELCOME AMINA ORFI.
