PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

TODAY - JUST FIVE YEARS AFTER LIFTING THE FALCON - HE NOW OWNS 16 ATP SINGLES TITLES, IS A 26-TIME TOUR FINALIST, A 10-TIME GRAND SLAM QUARTERFINALIST, AN OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALIST, A DAVIS CUP CHAMPION - AND HAS NOW SPENT NEARLY FIVE CONSECUTIVE YEARS AS ONE OF THE SPORT'S ELITE TOP-10 TALENTS. THROUGH TO THIS YEAR'S QUARTERS WITH STRAIGHT-SETS TRIUMPHS OVER ALEXANDER BUBLIK AND NUNO BORGES - DOHA, WELCOME BACK 2020 SINGLES, AND 2021 DOHA DOUBLES CHAMPION, ANDREY RUBLEV.
