A SEMIFINALIST HERE 2-YEARS-AGO IN HIS DOHA DEBUT .. THE SEASON ISN'T EVEN TWO MONTHS OLD - AND REMARKABLY, THIS 24-YEAR-OLD HAS ALREADY CAPTURED 2 TITLES. SO FAR, HE'S LIFTED THE TROPHY IN ADELAIDE, CAPTURED HIS 7TH CAREER SINGLES TITLE IN MONTPELLIER - AND HERE IN DOHA, CAME BACK FROM A SET-DOWN IN THE FIRST ROUND, DEFEATING QUALIFIER QUENTIN HALYS - BEFORE ADVANCING TO TODAY'S QUARTERS WITH A WALKOVER. RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #6, HE IS A DAVIS CUP CHAMPION, A US OPEN SEMIFINALIST, AN OLYMPIC BRONZE MEDALIST - AND THIS AFTERNOON, RETURNS TO DOHA'S CENTER COURT, DETERMINED TO RETURN TO THE FINAL-4. FROM CANADA, PLEASE WELCOME, FELIX AUGER-ALIASSIME.

BACK IN DOHA THIS WEEK FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE LIFTING THE FALCON 2-YEARS-AGO - ON TUESDAY, DOWN A SET, HE CAME BACK TO DEFEAT DEFENDING CHAMPION KAREN KHACHANOV - THEN LAST NIGHT, DIPATCHED BELGIUM'S ZIZOU BERGS - AND TONIGHT, RETURNS TO DOHA'S QUARTERFINALS WITH A PERFECT (6-0) RECORD, UNDFEATED ON THIS COURT. IN ALL, HE NOW OWNS 20 CAREER SINGLES TITLES, HAS REACHED AN ASTOUNDING 38 TOTAL FINALS, IS A US OPEN CHAMPION, A 6-TIME GRAND SLAM FINALIST, AN ATP FINALS AND DAVIS CUP CHAMPION - AND SPENT 16-WEEKS AS THE SPORT'S TOP-RANKED TALENT.
