LEBANON'S TOP-TALENT, IT HAS BEEN A MIND-BENDING SIX MONTHS FOR THIS 26-YEAR-OLD. OVER THE SUMMER IN PARIS, HE BECAME THE FIRST LEBANESE TENNIS PLAYER EVER TO REPRESENT HIS COUNTRY AT THE OLYMPIC GAMES, WHERE (ON THE HALLOWED CLAY AT ROLAND GARROS), HE FACED CARLOS ALCARAZ IN THE OPENING ROUND. IN DECEMBER, HE CAPTURED HIS FIRST ATP CHALLENGER SINGLES TITLE. THEN - LAST MONTH IN MELBOURNE, IN HIS GRAND SLAM DEBUT - HE QUALIFIED AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN, EARNED A STRAIGHT-SETS TRIUMPH IN ROUND-1, AND MADE HISTORY AGAIN - BECOMING THE ONLY LEBANESE TALENT EVER TO WIN A MAIN DRAW MATCH AT A MAJOR. A WILDCARD THIS WEEK IN DOHA, MAKING HIS QATAR EXXONMOBIL OPEN DEBUT .. FROM LEBANON - PLEASE WELCOME, HADY HABIB.
