A PERFECT (4-0) HERE IN DOHA - TONIGHT, HE RETURNS TO CENTER COURT FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE LIFTING THE FALCON 2-YEARS-AGO .. WHERE HE DEFEATED WORLD #9 FELIX AUGER-ALIASSIME IN THE SEMI'S, AND A RESURGENT ANDY MURRAY IN THE FINAL. THAT TRIUMPH WAS PART OF AN INCREDIBLE 19-MATCH WIN-STREAK, WHERE HE CAPTURED 3-TITLES, REACHED THE INDIAN WELLS FINAL, AND WENT ON TO LIFT THE TROPHY IN MIAMI BEFORE THE START OF THE CLAY SEASON.
