THE 2023 NEXT GEN ATP FINALS CHAMPION - AT JUST 21-YEARS-OLD, HE CONTINUES HIS STEADY CLIMB UP RANKINGS, AND HAS BECOME ONE OF THE MORE FORMIDABLE NEW FACES ON THE ATP TOUR. LAST YEAR, HE CAPPED THE SEASON BY REACHING HIS FIRST CAREER TOUR-LEVEL FINAL AT HOME IN BELGRADE. LAST MONTH, HE LAUNCHED THE NEW SEASON BY CAPTURING HIS 5TH CHALLENGER TITLE, CRACKED THE TOP-100, DEFEATED WORLD #13 HOLGER RUNE IN THE DAVIS CUP QUALIFIERS - AND LAST WEEK, EARNED HIS FIRST TOP-10 TRIUMPH - DEFEATING DANIIL MEDVEDEV TO REACH THE FINAL IN MARSEILLE. MAKING HIS DOHA DEBUT, WITH A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #73 - FROM SERBIA, PLEASE WELCOME HAMAD MEDJEDOVIC.

THAT YEAR, HE'D GO-ON TO REACH HIS FIRST THREE TOUR LEVEL FINALS, CAPTURE HIS DEBUT TITLE, LIFT THE TROPHY AT THE NEXT GEN ATP FINALS, AND COMPLETE HIS BREAK-THROUGH SEASON BBY CRACKING THE ATP'S TOP-15. TONIGHT, 7-YEARS-LATER - HE'S BACK ON CENTER COURT IN DOHA AS A 2-TIME GRAND SLAM FINALIST, AN ATP FINALS CHAMPION, AND A 5-TIME YEAR-END TOP-10 TALENT WHO'S CAPTURED 11 ATP SINGLES TITLES IN A REMARKABLE 29 CAREER FINALS.
