BACK UNDER THE LIGHTS ON CENTER COURT IN DOHA - WHERE TUESDAY, SHE EARNED ONE OF THE BIGGEST TRIUMPHS OF HER CAREER, DEFEATING WORLD #3 COCO GAUFF - TONIGHT, SHE'S THROUGH TO DOHA'S QUARTERS FOR THE FIRST TIME . . . AND AFTER LAST YEAR'S RUN TO THE FINAL-4 AT INDIAN WELLS - IS BATTLING FOR A SPOT IN HER SECOND WTA-1000 SEMIFINAL. IN FACT, THIS TIME LAST YEAR, SHE WAS ON FIRE! SHE REACHED HER FIRST GRAND SLAM SINGLES QUARTERFINAL AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN, THE FINAL IN SAN DIEGO - AND IN STUTTGART, UPSET 3 TOP-10 TALENTS TO REACH THE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH. BY THE TIME THE SMOKE CLEARED - SHE HAD JUMPED 21-POSITIONS AND CLIMBED TO A CAREER-HIGH OF WORLD #16. THIS WEEK IN DOHA, SHE'S AT IT AGAIN.
