PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

AT JUST 17-YEARS-OLD, THIS TEENAGE SENSATION ARRIVED IN DOHA WITH A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #15, AFTER A TREMENDOUS 2024 WHERE SHE MADE HER GRAND SLAM SEMIFINAL DEBUT AT ROLAND GARROS - DEFEATING WORLD #2 ARYNA SABALENKA TO REACH THE FINAL-4. SHE THEN CAPTURED HER FIRST WTA SINGLES TITLE, EARNED DOUBLES SILVER IN PARIS, AND FINISHED THE SEASON WITH A FINALIST-RUN IN NINGBO, CHINA. THIS YEAR - SHE'S AT IT AGAIN! A SEMIFINALIST IN BRISBANE, SHE WENT-ON TO CAPTURE THE BRISBANE DOUBLES TITLE - AND REACHED HER FIRST GRAND SLAM DOUBLES SEMIFINAL AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN.
