BACK ON CENTER STAGE IN DOHA AS THE DEFENDING AND ONLY 3-TIME CHAMPION - TONIGHT, AFTER A 1ST-ROUND BYE, SHE LAUNCHES HER 2025 CAMPAIGN IN PURSUIT OF HER 13TH CONSECUTIVE MATCH VICTORY ON THIS COURT. AND AT JUST 23-YEARS-OLD - REMARKABLY - IS NOW A 5-TIME GRAND SLAM CHAMPION, A WTA FINALS CHAMPION, AN OLYMPIC BRONZE MEDALIST, HAS HELD THE WORLD #1 RANKING FOR 125-WEEKS COMBINED, AND IS A 2-TIME YEAR-END WORLD #1. IN ALL, IN JUST FIVE SEASONS, SH HAS COLLECTED 22 SINGLES TITLES IN 26 CAREER FINALS - INCLUDING A HAUL OF 10 WTA-1000 TITLES. FROM POLAND - WELCOME BACK 3-TIME AND DEFENDING DOHA CHAMPION, IGA SWIATEK.
