PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

MAKING HER DOHA CENTER COURT DEBUT - ON SUNDAY, SHE DEFEATED WILD CARD ZEYNEP SONMEZ IN STRAIGHT-SETS - AND IS THROUGH TO ROUND-2 OF THE QATAR TOTALENERGIES OPEN FOR A SECOND TIME. THIS TIME LAST YEAR, SHE WAS ON FIRE . . . SHE REACHED HER FIRST GRAND SLAM SINGLES QUARTERFINAL AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN, THE FINAL IN SAN DIEGO, MADE HER WTA-1000 SEMIFINAL DEBUT AT INDIAN WELLS - AND IN STUTTGART, UPSET 3 TOP-10 TALENTS TO REACH THE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH. WHEN THE SMOKE CLEARED - SHE LEAPT 21-SPOTS IN THE RANKINGS AND CLIMBED TO A CAREER-HIGH OF WORLD #16. IN PURSUIT OF HER 9TH TOP-10 TRIUMPH . . . FROM UKRAINE - PLEASE WELCOME, MARTA KOSTYUK.

WEEK-1 - SHE WENT UNDEFEATED, LIFTING TEAM USA TO THE 2025 UNITED CUP TITLE - THEN IN MELBOURNE, REACHED HER 8TH CAREER GRAND SLAM QUARTERFINAL AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN. AT JUST 20-YEARS-OLD - IN ALL, SHE NOW OWNS 1 GRAND SLAM SINGLES TITLE, IS A ROLAND GARROS DOUBLES CHAMPION, HAS EARNED 9 CAREER TITLES IN BOTH SINGLES AND DOUBLES - AND HAS BEEN RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #2. FROM THE UNITED STATES - WELCOME BACK 2023 US OPEN CHAMPION AND THE #3 PLAYER IN THE WORLD, COCO GAUFF.
