NOW A 3-TIME GRAND SLAM FINALIST - OVER THE PAST FOUR YEARS, WITH UNRELENTING DETERMINATION, THIS TUNISIAN TRAILBLAZER HAS CEMENTED HER SPOT AT THE TOP OF THE SPORT - CAPTURING 5 TITLES, REACHING 13 FINALS, CLIMBING ALL THE WAY TO A CAREER-HIGH RANKING OF WORLD #2.
