A FORMER ALL AMERICAN AT PEPPERDINE UNIVERSITY – THIS 29-YEAR-OLD ... IS A TENNIS TRAILBLAZER. THE FIRST EGYPTIAN WOMAN EVER TO WIN A MAIN-DRAW MATCH AT A MAJOR – IN 2022, SHE BECAME THE FIRST WOMAN FROM EGYPT TO CAPTURE A WTA SINGLES TITLE – AND TODAY, REMAINS THE HIGHEST RANKED EGYPTIAN SINGLES TALENT (MAN OR WOMAN) IN THE OPEN ERA.
