IN 2010 - AT JUST 15-YEARS-OLD - HE MADE HIS Q-TERMINALS QATAR CLASSIC DEBUT AS AN UNRANKED QUALIFYING WILD CARD. TONIGHT, 15-YEARS-LATER, HE STEPS BACK INTO DOHA'S SPOTLIGHT AS THE WORLD #21 - AND QATAR'S GREATEST SQUASH TALENT OF ALL TIME. 3-YEARS-AGO, HE DEFEATED WORLD #2 PAUL COLL ON THIS COURT EN ROUTE TO HIS FIRST CAREER PLATINUM QUARTERFINAL. IN 2023, HE CAPTURED HIS FIRST PSA BRONZE TITLE BETWEEN THESE WALLS, DEFEATING TAREK MOMEN IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH. AND EARLIER THIS MONTH IN GIZA - HE MADE A RUN TO THE LAST-16 OF THE EGYPTIAN OPEN WITH A 3-GAME TRIUMPH OVER FORMER WORLD #1 AND 4-TIME QATAR CLASSIC CHAMPION ... MOHAMED ELSHORBAGY.
