REMARKABLY, AT JUST 21-YEARS-OLD, SHE IS NOW A 2-TIME MAJOR SINGLES CHAMPION, 3-TIME FINALIST, A WTA FINALS CHAMPION - AND IN ALL, OWNS 10 CAREER SINGLES TITLES, 10 DOUBLES TITLES, HAS BEEN RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #2 IN SINGLES, AND WORLD #1 IN DOUBLES. FROM DELRAY BEACH FLORIDA - FANS, GIVE IT UP FOR 2023 US OPEN CHAMPION ... COCO GAUFF.
