PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

LAST MONTH, THIS 24-YEAR-OLD EARNED HER 6TH CAREER GRAND SLAM TRIUMPH AT WIMBLEDON – AND FOR ONLY THE THIRD TIME IN HISTORY – CAPTURED THE TITLE WITHOUT LOSING A SINGLE GAME IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH. IN ALL, SHE NOW OWNS 24 CAREER SINGLES TITLES, IS AN OLYMPIC BRONZE MEDALIST, A 2-TIME YEAR-END WORLD #1, HAS HELD THE SPORT'S TOP-RANKING FOR 125-WEEKS COMBINED – AND TONIGHT, AFTER HER TRIUMPH LAST WEEK IN CINCINNATI, RETURNS TO CENTER STAGE IN NEW YORK ...
