BACK IN DOHA THIS WEEK FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE LIFTING THE FALCON 2-YEARS-AGO - ON TUESDAY, DOWN A SET, HE CAME BACK TO DEFEAT DEFENDING CHAMPION KAREN KHACHANOV - THEN LAST NIGHT, DIPATCHED BELGIUM'S ZIZOU BERGS - AND TONIGHT, RETURNS TO DOHA'S QUARTERFINALS WITH A PERFECT (6-0) RECORD, UNDFEATED ON THIS COURT. IN ALL, HE NOW OWNS 20 CAREER SINGLES TITLES, HAS REACHED AN ASTOUNDING 38 TOTAL FINALS, IS A US OPEN CHAMPION, A 6-TIME GRAND SLAM FINALIST, AN ATP FINALS AND DAVIS CUP CHAMPION - AND SPENT 16-WEEKS AS THE SPORT'S TOP-RANKED TALENT. DOHA WELCOME BACK, THE WORLD #6, DANIIL MEDVEDEV.

PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

CONTINUING HIS COMEBACK FROM AN INJURY SHORTENED SEASON LAST YEAR - TONIGHT, THIS 21-YEAR-OLD CHINESE TRAILBLAZER MAKES HIS DOHA DEBUT ON CENTER COURT ... WITH A SHOT AT A FORMER CHAMPION. 3-YEARS-AGO, AT JUST 18-YEARS-OLD, HE QUALIFIED IN HIS GRAND SLAM DEBUT AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN - THEN BECAME THE FIRST CHINESE MAN IN THE OPEN ERA TO WIN A MAIN DRAW MATCH IN MELBOURNE. A YEAR LATER, HE REACHED ROUND-3 OF BOTH THE AUSTRALIAN AND US OPENS, CAPTURED HIS FIRST SINGLES TITLE IN CHENGDU - AND CRACKED THE ATP'S TOP-50 FOR THE FIRST TIME.
