IN 2013, SHE MADE HER DOHA DEBUT AS A 17-YEAR-OLD QUALIFYING WILD CARD. 13 YEARS LATER - SHE IS NOW A 2-TIME GRAND SLAM SEMIFINALIST, HAS BEEN RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #3 - AND HAS REACHED THE FINAL-4 OF THE YEAR-END WTA FINALS TWICE. IN ALL, SHE OWNS 2 WTA SINGLES TITLES (INCLUDING THE 2023 WTA-1000 TITLE IN GUADALAJARA) - AND IS AN 8-TIME FINALIST ON TOUR. ON TUESDAY, SHE EARNED HER 28TH CAREER TOP-10 TRIUMPH, ELIMINATING JASMINE PAOLINI - TONIGHT, SHE'S DETERMINED TO MAKE IT 29. FROM GREECE, PLEASE WELCOME ... MARIA SAKKARI.
