IN ALL, SHE OWNS 2 WTA SINGLES TITLES (INCLUDING THE 2023 WTA-1000 TITLE IN GUADALAJARA) - AND IS AN 8-TIME FINALIST ON TOUR. ON TUESDAY, SHE EARNED HER 28TH CAREER TOP-10 TRIUMPH, ELIMINATING JASMINE PAOLINI - TONIGHT, SHE'S DETERMINED TO MAKE IT 29. FROM GREECE, PLEASE WELCOME ... MARIA SAKKARI.
