PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

THE 2017 QATAR TOTAL ENERGIES OPEN CHAMPION - 9 YEARS AGO, DURING RAIN-SOAKED WEEK, SHE WON BOTH HER QUARTERFINAL AND SEMIFINAL MATHES ON THE SAME DAY - THEN DEFEATED CAROLINE WOZNIACKI TO LIFT THE FALCON. A 2-TIME GRAND SLAM FINALIST AND 3-TIME BILLIE JEAN KING CUP CHAMPION - IN ALL, SHE OWNS 17 CAREER SINGLES TITLES - IS A 34-TIME FINALIST ON TOUR - AND IN 2017, CLAIMED THE WORLD #1 RANKING. CONTINUING HER COMEBACK - AFTER MISSING MOST OF LAST SEASON WITH INJURY - YESTERDAY, SHE DEFEATED SOLANA SIERRA TO REACH TONIGHT'S 2ND-ROUND MATCH. FROM CZECHIA - DOHA, WELCOME BACK ... THE DEFENDING QATAR TOTAL ENERGIES OPEN CHAMPION - LAST YEAR, RANKED OUTSIDE THE TOP-40 ... SHE EARNED SIX CONSECUTIVE TRIUMPHS ON THIS COURT - AND ON SATURDAY NIGHT, STOOD CENTER STAGE, LIFTING DOHA'S FALCON ... HER FIRST WTA-1000 TITLE. BUT THAT WAS JUST THE BEGINNING.
