TODAY - JUST FOUR YEARS LATER - SHE RETURNS AS A 2-TIME GRAND SLAM SINGLES CHAMPION, A ROLAND GARROS DOUBLES CHAMPION, A WTA FINALS CHAMPION ... WITH 21 CAREER TITLES IN SINGLES AND DOUBLES COMBINED. A YEAR-END TOP-3 TALENT FOR 3 CONSECUTIVE SEASONS - THIS AFTERNOON, SHE LAUNCHES HER 2026 MIDDLE EAST SWING CAMPAIN - BACK ON CENTER STAGE IN DOHA - IN PURSUIT OF HER 4TH WTA-1000 SINGLES TITLE. • Nov: Gauff and Pegula became first Americans since Serena and Venus (2009) to qualify for both the Singles and Doubles at WTA Finals

2019

• Wimbledon R1 - defeated former World #1 and 7-time major champion, Venus Williams - went on to reach R4 (just 15-years-old)

2019

• Captured the title in Linz at just 15-years-old - becoming the youngest player to win a WTA title since 2004

2017

• Former World #1 Junior and US Open Junior Finalist - the youngest Junior Finalist in US Open history
