THE ONLY 3-TIME DOHA CHAMPION ... IN 2024 - SHE GRADUATED FROM PEPPERDINE UNIVERSITY - AND IMMEDIATELY STARTED LIFTING TROPHIES ON THE ITF CIRCUIT. THEN, OVER THE SUMMER IN NEW YORK - AS A QUALIFIER AT THE US OPEN - SHE MADE HER TOUR-LEVEL DEBUT - DEFEATING WORLD #25 VERONIKA KUDERMETOVA - BECOMING THE FIRST WOMAN FROM HER COUNTRY TO WIN A GRAND SLAM MATCH IN OVER 20-YEARS. SHE WENT ON TO REACH TO FINAL IN SAO PAULO - WON THE TITLE IN CHENNAI - AND BY SEASON'S END, NEARLY CRACKED THE TOP-50. THIS AFTERNOON - FOLLOWING HER 1ST-ROUND TRIUMPH OVER BEATRIZ HADDAD MAIA - SHE'S EARNED HER FIRST CAREER SHOT AT A TOP-5 TALENT. FROM INDONESIA - LET'S HEAR IT FOR JANICE TJEN.
