THE ONLY 3-TIME DOHA CHAMPION ... THE TWO UPSET LEGENDS MARTINA HINGIS AND SANIA MIRZA TO REACH THE 2016 SEMIFINALS ... AND A YEAR LATER - AT JUST 19-YEARS-OLD - SHE STUNNED WORLD #2 ANGELIQUE KERBER ON THIS COURT TO REACH THE 2017 SINGLES QUARTERS. SINCE THEN, SHE'S CAPTURED 8 WTA SINGLES TITLES, IS A ROLAND GARROS SEMIFINALIST, A BILLIE JEAN KING CUP CHAMPION, AND HAS BEEN RANKED AS HIGH AS WORLD #8.
